Theatre Workshop

The Dramatics Association of St Aloysius College (Autonomous) had organized "Ranga Habba" in association with Rangayana Sanchari Rangha Ghataka, Mysuru on 12, 13 & 14th of April 2019 in Mother Teresa Peace Park from 6:30 pm onwards. During these three days, three plays namely- 'Rex Hours', 'Yahoodi hudugi' and 'Puntila' were staged.

The beginning was marked with an inaugural program. Rev. Fr Dionysius Vaz, SJ, Rector St. Aloysius Institutions, Rev. Dr. Praveen Martis, SJ, Principal, St Aloysius



College (Autonomous), faculties Mr Lawrence Pinto and Mrs Bhavya Shetty inaugurated the drama festival on 12 April 2019 and wished well for the same.

'Rex Hours - Journeys of Lost Dino'. The traditional form of Japanese puppetry called 'Bunraku' was utilized for the execution of this play on the first day of the drama festival. Puppeteer Shравan Heggodu directed the show. As the name indicates, the show was based on the life, and journeys of the lost giant species of the earth - the dinosaurs. The show aims at depicting the dinosaurs' struggle for survival, set against the order of nature.

On the second day of the drama festival, the play 'Yahoodi hudugi' directed by Bhagirathi Baayi Kandam written by Agha Harsh Kashmiri and translated to

kannada by Itagi Eranna was staged. The play setup which took the audience to the time of the play was designed by H K Dwarkanath, costumes that blended well with the artists was designed by Jeena Mani. The melodious music that kept the audience engaging was given by Srinivas Bhat (Cheeni) and Digvijay Heggodu assisted by Subrahmanaiya Mysore, Dhanaranjay and Lasya. The effective lighting that added colors was controlled by Pavan Kumar.

The story features the rivalry between the Roman priest Brutus and the oppressed Jewish merchant, Prince Ezra. Brutus sentences Ezra's son to death and Ezra in turn kidnaps and raises Brutus' only daughter, Decia. When the daughter, renamed Hannah, grows up, the Roman Prince Marcus falls in love with her. To court her, he disguises his Roman identity. When his religion is discovered, he is ejected from Ezra's house. Marcus then agrees to marry Princess Octavia as arranged, but Hannah denounces him in open court and he is sentenced to death by his own father, the emperor. When Hannah and Ezra respond to Octavia's pleas and retract their accusations, they in turn are sentenced to death by Brutus.

The final play was 'Puntila' directed by Ashish Pathak written by Bertolt Brecht and translated to kannada by Jaswanth Yadav. The stage settings for the play were designed by H K Dwarkanath, costumed were designed by Shashikala B N. The engaging music for the play was given by Subrahmanaiya Mysore. The effective lighting was controlled by Mahesh Kallathi.

The story describes the aristocratic land-owner Puntila's relationship to his servant, Matti, as well as his daughter, Eva, who he wants to marry off to an Attaché. Eva herself loves Matti and so Puntila has to decide whether to marry his daughter to his driver or to an Attache, while he also deals with a drinking problem.

The efforts put in by Rangayana Sanchari Rangha Ghataka, Mysuru was fruitful as it became a part of audience's good books. Every detail from the costume to screenplay was appreciated, thus the drama festival ended on a good note.
