Colloquium on "National Education Policy 2020"

The St. Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangaluru organised the National Colloquium titled "National Education Policy 2020" under the UGC-Paramarsh Scheme to enable a better coherence of the policy. The Colloquium was held on Wednesday 26th August 2020 from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.

The New Education Policy (NEP), 2020, charts one of the most far reaching agenda to restructure educational curriculum across India from early childhood to higher edu-



Undoubtedly, there is much wanting in the curriculum available to an average student in India today, across the various stages of schooling and higher education. NEP promises a comprehensive corrective design: recommends reordering school education from the existing 10+2 pattern into 5+3+3+4, to cover 3-18 years old; imparting school education in local languages' turning Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) into multidisciplinary universities; and use of appropriate technological tools at all levels of education.

In this context, the panel discussion focused on the following four domains that inform this document:

- The substantive recommendations of the NEP, 2020
- The omissions, silences and detours that inform NEP, 2020
- The prior conceptual and moralistic assumptions replete in NEP, 2020 and their consequences.
- Problems in the execution and implementation of NEP, 2020.

The panelists spoke on different angles of NEP 2020.

Professor Valerian Rodrigues (Former professor and Dean of the Faculty of Arts, Mangalore University and former professor at Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi) spoke on the theme "The NEP 2020: A Critical Overview". He gave an overview of the NEP 2020 while drawing its positives and negatives of the document by

examining the four components of the policy such as a, i) the goals and principles of NEP; ii) Charter for school iii) recommendations iv) the support regime. He pointed out to the excellent critique given on the existing school curriculum while the policy rightly stresses on the need to impart education in the mother tongue, on teaching Sanskrit, etc. The policy reflected innovative and imaginative solutions as against rote learning. Pointing to the negatives, Prof. Rodrigues argued that the document should have been foregrounded on the Preamble of India's constitution as the leading principled stance. Second he questioned as to where is the social capital to carry out the design suggested by NEP? Third he called NEP 2020 as an Archimedean design wherein there was the lack of political consensus.

Professor Shyam Menon, (Professor at the Central Institute of Education, University of Delhi since 1994 and the Founding Vice Chancellor of the Ambedkar University Delhi, during 2008-2018) addressed on "NEP- Questioning the seriousness of Purpose". His lecture dealt with two parts: the policy being an attempt to resurrect from the bureaucratic debris and second, the undermining of federalism in India. The attempt appeared more of a political project of denying history and producing every-



thing on a blank state. Given the fact that federalism in India was accepted to accommodate diversities, this document attempted to introduce centralization, standardization and uniformity. Rather the ownership of the state is missing through NEP 2020 though education appears constitutionally as a subject within the Concurrent List. The fact that the document deviated from the earlier policies on education laid in the bypassing of the Indian Parliament.

Prof. Geetha B. Nambissan, (former Professor of Sociology of Education at the Zakir Husain Centre for Educational Studies (ZHCES), Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi) spoke on "NEP- Right to Education of

Children from the Marginal Groups in relation to Social justice". She on the onset stated that a policy of any country is a process. The earlier two policies on education were framed by the nation-state. The current policy has the undertone of globalization and corporatism. She understood that the corporate sector's provision of education was in the interest of the public and for private profit which was okay. She asserted that the private can be the new public. However, she cautioned that that the quality of education particularly for the underprivileged

groups, including those who send their children to low priced English medium schools where quality is worse than government schools, lacks the true conceptualization of equality of learning in this document. There is a need to draw attention to advocacy and research before implementation.

Dr. Frazer Mascarenhas SJ, (Principal of St. Xavier's College, Mumbai and member of Working Group for Undergraduate Education of the National Knowledge Commission, 2006) spoke exclusively from the context of rights of both linguistic and religious minorities under the topic, "NEP and The Concerns of Minorities". While highlighting some of the best words from the document viz., innovation, adaption to change, all-round development of capabilities, role of teachers, etc. he noted the total dismantling of the earlier system was not conducive. He argued that institutions particularly the minority institutions were at the forefront of providing the best education as proven by the government cum private institutional rankings. He criticized the formation of the policy that did not find a member from the minority community particularly from the Christian community while many of the colleges belonging to the latter group appeared in top performance ranks. The document saw the complete absence of references to the marginalized, minority rights and the emphasis on a constitutional value like secularism. He posed an important question: given the present composition of the Supreme Court judges, will the basic structure of India's constitution get altered? NEP is hence ultra vires of the Constitution in spirit.

Professor A. R. Vasavi, (Social Anthropologist, is based in Karnataka) addressed the theme, "Impact of NEP on the rural children and communities". She reiterated the positives of the NEP 2020 document viz., the need for early childhood care, recognition of nutrition including the introduction of free breakfasts along with mid-day meals, etc. while pointing to the political aspirations of those who have a specific agenda. The policy overlooked the rural complexities that included migration and the displacement of population; the poor quality of education; etc. The policy would find the enhancement of

an, already, hierarchical society. The fact that the inputs from different voices of the Indian society particularly the rural were not taken into consideration mocks at the realization of democracy and failed to address the structural deficit. The children in a village go to different schools rather discourages the forging of shared interests at the community level.

The programme was presided over by Rev Dr Praveen Martis SJ, Principal of St Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangaluru along with the Convenor of the Colloquium Dr Rose Veera D Souza, Dean of Faculty of Arts and HOD, Political Science who moderated the colloquium. The entire program was overseen by the Program Coordinator, Mr Alwin D'Souza, in assistance with Mrs. Maria Shaila D'Souza Asst Profs. from the Dept. of Political Science. Dr. Joyce S. Lobo anchored the colloquium. The colloquium saw the raising of pertinent questions on secularism, decentralization, school drop-outs, triple language, diverse culture and inter-state differences, minority rights etc.

Webinar Series—2: National Webinar on 'Cheminformatics'

The UG and PG departments of Chemistry Organized a National Webinar on 'Cheminformatics' On June 17, 2020 at 10.00AM via online platform.

Dr S Kabilan - Professor and Chairperson, Annamalai University, Tamil Nadu, was the guest speaker for the session. The Webinar began with a prayer, followed by welcome note by Ms Nandini Shet, Asst. Prof., Dept. of Chemistry, where she also introduced the Guest Speaker Dr S Kabilan.

Addressing the Participants Rev Dr Praveen Martis SJ said, "I compliment the department of chemistry for their great efforts in organizing this kind of Webinars, which has received tremendous response. Many more attempts like this will boost students to take up Chemistry and also explore in the research field".

Dr S Kabilan started the talk by congratulating the department of Chemistry for organizing webinar in this pandemic situation. He spoke about the basics of Cheminformatics and its application on Modern drug Delivery. Speaking about the topic Dr Kabilan said Cheminformatics has mainly dealt with small molecules, whereas bioinformatics addresses genes, proteins, and other

larger chemical compounds. Chem and Bioinformatics complements each other for bimolecular process, like structure and function of proteins, the binding of a ligand to its binding site, the conversion of a substrate within its enzyme receptor, and the catalysis of a biochemical reaction by an enzyme. Further he also said that Cheminformatics plays a key role to maintain and access enormous amount of chemical data, produced by chemist (more than 45 million chemical compounds are known and the number may increase in million every year,) by using a proper database. Also, the field of chemistry needs a novel technique for knowledge extraction from data to model complex relationships between the structure of the chemical compound and biological activity or the influence of reaction condition on chemical reactivity. Cheminformatics has wider range of application and influence if cheminformatics in some specific research areas like Toxicology, Environment, and Pharmacology etc.

The webinar was concluded with the Discussion and Thanking note by Ms Ashwini - Lecturer Department of Chemistry. More than 400 Participants had actively taken part in the webinar.

Dr Sumana Dutta explained about neuronal impulses, cardiac activity, circadian rhythms, bacterial colonies, intricate patterns in nature, spiral galaxies, vortices in fluids, food chain in ecological systems, weather forecasting and reaction-diffusion systems, all have something

Webinar Series—4: 3D Electron Microscopy for Structural Nanotechnology'

The UG and PG Departments of Chemistry organized an International Webinar on '3D Electron Microscopy for Structural Nanotechnology' by Dr. Nonappa on June 25, 2020 at 11.00 AM via online platform.

Dr. Nonappa in his talk acknowledged being a participant and winner of one of the 'Imprints' events organized by St. Aloysius College during his student days. He then presented his talk with a brief history of the development of Electron Microscopy technique starting from the discovery of electrons by J. J. Thomson in 1897 and the invention of first electron microscope by Knoll and Ruska in 1930's. He highlighted that its development has taken a huge leap over the years, with the introduction of three-dimensional scanning and transmission electron microscopes which can analyse highly complex molecules in nature. A sophisticated set up consists of cryo-electron microscope in which images can be made of the surface of frozen materials and is a convenient tool in visualizing the biological samples. The 3-D tissue imaging technique helps to know how cells are organized in three-dimensional biological network, which further helps to determine how cells can interact. Furthermore, cellular tomography method using TEM is used for biological samples in order to obtain a detailed high-resolution 3-D structures of subcellular macromolecular objects. Three dimensional images are also created by techniques such as stereoscopy and photogrammetry and array tomography. The speaker demonstrated the methods with some of his recently published work which exclusively made use of electron tomographic reconstruction, high-resolution TEM and other imaging techniques to determine structures of 3-D nanoclusters, nanowires, nanoparticle superlattices as well as biological samples.

At the end of the session the speaker actively engaged in a discussion with the participants and answered various questions on the topic. The session was concluded with a thanking note by Ms Jyothi Vaz, Dept. of UG Chemistry. This online session had an active participation of over 500 participants from different institutions who have also provided a positive feedback about the webinar.

Webinar Series—5: Chemist For 21st Century

The Dept. of Chemistry conducted webinar 5 on the topic Chemist For 21st century on 27th June 2020 at 10:00am through the online Platform. Eminent chemist Dr Susanta Samajdar, Senior vice president & Head Drug discovery unit, Aurigene Discovery Technologies Limited, Bangalore was the speaker of the webinar.

Dr Susanta received his PhD in Synthetic Organic Chemistry from Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science (IACS), Kolkata and subsequently moved to MD Anderson Cancer Center for a Post-Doctoral training on anti-cancer drug discovery. He has over 16 years of synthetic and Medicinal Chemistry research experience in Indian Industries. Dr Susanta has experience in leading multi-disciplinary drug discovery teams that successfully delivered several preclinical development candidates. He has experience in working with various target classes including GPCRs, Ion channels, Proteases, Kinases and NHRs, across different therapeutic areas like Oncology, Pain and Inflammation, Metabolic Disorders and Neurosciences. Exploring newer tools and technologies in small molecule drug discovery research remains one of Dr Susanta's favorite subjects. He has more than 20 research publications and more than 25 patent applications to his credit. At present Dr Susanta is Vice President in Medicinal Chemistry and leads discovery research portfolio at Aurigene Discovery Technologies Ltd.

Dr Susanta in his talk focused on the importance of Chemists in the current century. He highlighted that the need for research is of utmost importance. He said the field of science has been evolving in variable dimensions since time immemorial. The need for chemists is at the peak in the field of Drug design, chemical synthesis, organic synthesis and analysis, spectroscopic techniques and more in analytical field incorporated with separation techniques and so on. The need for upgradations not just a requirement instead it's a pre-requisite. The contributions of chemists all over the globe has been tremendous and thus gave a call to the budding chemists to aim high and think big.

Rev. Dr Praveen Martis, Principal St Aloysius College (Autonomous), welcomed the gathering, Dr Ronald Nazareth, Associate Professor, Head, Dept. of chemistry organized the webinar, Ms. Preema Cealla Pais was the organizing secretary and compered the programme.

Topic : Qualitative to Quantitative, Understanding of Processes : How and Why?

Brief report : Prof Nand Kishore talked about the thermodynamic processes in chemical reactions both at micro and macro level. He said thermodynamics studies the interrelation of heat and work with chemical reactions or with physical changes of state that happen within the confines of thermodynamics. He described how Gibbs free energy changes in chemical reactions and how the value of gibbs free energy gives the nature of chemical reaction that has taken place. He also talked about human thermodynamics where heat and its relation to the motion and changes in the equilibriums of human bodies. He also

Topic : Stereochemistry of Organic Compounds.

Report : Prof I N N Namboothiri spoke about the importance of stereochemistry in chemical reactions and its importance in pharma industries.

He also gave a detailed description of racemic mixtures, separation of racemic mixtures, characterization of pure stereoisomers. He also spoke about the racemization of heterotropic ligands and faces (prostereoisomerism, prochirality), stereochemistry of alkenes, conformation of acyclic molecules configuration and conformation of cyclic molecules.

He also gave a brief outline of stereoselective synthesis of organic compounds and talked about chirality in molecules that are not having chiral centers.

technologies for national defense and homeland security. However, the field is currently trying to expand beyond its traditional core towards area related to biology, material science and nanotechnology. Areas such as nanoscience, biological chemistry, and material chemistry is continuing to attract funding initiatives. Chemistry students will have much scope to use their knowledge in a range of research sectors, including roles within chemical and related industries and healthcare and more. Research careers are more diverse than they might first appear, as there are many different reasons to conduct research and many possible environments. Chemistry may need to be increasingly interdisciplinary and there could be a significant shift from blue-skies to problem-driven research. Chemistry for impact -It is likely the chemical sciences will be increasingly required to solve challenges in energy and climate change, food production and clean water. Chemistry might have an increased role in biochemistry and the pharmaceutical industry, as well as in the maintenance and development of infrastructure. Chemistry education might need a more integrated approach that is increasingly hands-on and interdisciplinary. There is likely to be global growth in demand for the chemical sciences, which might not necessarily result in a significant shift of chemistry to low-cost economies. Advances in technology are likely to remain a major trend, with far-reaching implications for the future of the chemical sciences. Experimentation is expected to become radically more efficient. This will impact research, who is able to conduct this work and the necessary infrastructure. Computational developments,

combined with advances in real-time and high-throughput experimentation, may radically reduce the time required for modelling and to get stuff out of the lab. Approaches to research on organic synthesis, general catalytic chemistry and testing the physical properties of models will see changes, and chemists are expected to become even more focused on thermodynamics. The production of "molecules on demand" may follow,

although this development probably sits beyond our ten to twenty-year time horizon. Chemists may be able to produce models on demand for specific clients". He also advised the students to make the best use of the opportunities available in the present days and appreciated the efforts of the organizers for the successful conduct of the webinar.

Webinar Series-9: Chemical Ecology

The global pandemic has left us with the situation of total unrest, be it with respect to our work, societal approach or academic growth. But a problem along with it, also challenges our approach to newer ways of handling things.

Turning this emergency situation into an occasion to promote international collaboration to share experiences,

knowledge and resources, Department of Chemistry, St. Aloysius college

(Autonomous) organized series of national

and international webinars with subject experts and the 9th webinar was held on August 4, 2020 on Chemical Ecology. Resource person for this international webinar was Padma Bhushan, Padma Shri, Prof. Padmanabhan Balaram, Biochemist, Former Director of Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore.

Rev. Dr Praveen Martis SJ, Principal, St Aloysius College (Autonomous) addressed the participants and welcomed the distinguished speaker.

Prof. Balaram began his talk with the comparison of characteristics of two major fields of Science-Chemistry and Biology. Chemical ecology is a branch of science that focusses on balance between chemistry and biology. Mainly, chemistry is dominated by analytical aspects but biology is dominated by creative aspects of science. Chemicals are present everywhere in nature and chemical ecology makes us aware of the chemical diversity in biology and communication between biological organisms through chemicals. For example, cell to cell communication occurs through hormones and organisms communicate through pheromones. Secretion of pheromone called Bombyketol by female silk-moth to attract male silk-moths is one of the oldest such reactions studied. There are examples of organisms belonging to different species which also communicate with one another through chemical molecules. It is found that termites are able to communicate through chemicals with some species of fungus in the process of building termite-mounds. Beetles named Bombardier beetles are able to produce flame at high temperatures as high as 100°C through chemical reaction.

Thus Prof. Balaram explained with the help of a number of examples, the communications between organisms and their environment and said that chemical ecology is nothing but the scientific analysis and study of interactions among organisms and their environment. In other words, chemical ecology is a fusion of field biology and natural product chemistry. Prof Balaram described the reasons and features of such interactions. Every interaction involves some physical or chemical stimulus acting on a receptor molecule such as proteins which triggers a

series of biochemical reactions. Chemical communication between the molecules is very specific and follows lock and key mechanism.

Prof. Balam spoke about various natural products such as alkaloids, terpenes, polyketides and the chemical reactions involved in the biosynthesis of such products. In nature, it is easier to synthesise larger molecules such as proteins than smaller molecules since it is observed that larger molecules catalyse the synthesis of smaller molecules.

Prof. Balam also touched upon the role of technology in the development of science especially in chemistry and biology. Throughout his talk, Prof. Balam stressed upon the contributions of various scientists such as E. Fischer, T. Eisner etc., which laid the foundation to the development of biochemistry and molecular biology.

Prof. Balam concluded his talk with how chemical ecology could be used to control diseases such as COVID-19 caused by pathogens because according to Prof. Balam whenever nature creates pathogens, it also creates means to control pathogens.

The talk was followed by interaction with the participants.

Around 1900 participants participated in the Webinar through Youtube and Zoom platforms. Dr Ronald Nazareth - Head, Undergraduate and Postgraduate Departments of Chemistry and Coordinator of Star College Scheme thanked the resource person and all the participants. Webinar Series—10: Drug Discovery - Is it that easy? The mysterious coronavirus outbreak and its fast spread to many countries has made people to get used to the new normal. When it comes to the academics, though this pandemic has made the days bit troubled for the normal learning style, E learning has made promote international collaborations to share experiences, knowledge and resources. Turning this emergency situation for the good of academic growth, the Department of Chemistry of St Aloysius College has organized series of national and International webinars. The 10th webinar in this series being the Drug Discovery - Is it that easy? by Prof Uday Maitra, the Professor of Organic Chemistry, Indian Institute of Science Bengaluru on 7th August, 2020 at 11.00am.

The programme began with the covid-19 prayer prepared by the Karnataka Jesuits and welcome by Dr. Jyothi Rao. This was followed by the Principal's message. The programme coordinator Dr. Divya N Shetty introduced the speaker.

Prof Maithra talked about the current scenario and the issues faced in designing new drugs from concept stage to the final marketing stage and also about the reactions of drugs in the body.

Prof Maithra talked time and expenses in getting one drug to the market which happens after screening nearly 10 drugs in human trials and 10000 compounds in animal studies. Each drug takes about 12-15 years to get to market after expenses of nearly 2.5 billion dollars.

In 2013 out of nearly 27 drugs approved, only one came from India which reflects our low spending on R&D. He also talked about the Pharmacodynamic and Pharmacokinetic studies carried out on the drugs.



Drug Design – is it really that easy?

He informed that protein Angiotensin-1 break down by enzyme ACE is responsible for hypertension and hence drugs like Captopril and Enalapril target this enzyme ACE and hence inhibit breakdown of Angiotensin-1.

He dealt in detail about the search for drugs that inhibit enzymes in the pathogens thereby rendering them inactive but at the same time these drugs don't act on enzymes in the host. Many of the diseases are not caused by enzymes themselves but by the by product of their reactions in the host body.

Prof Maithra spoke about the Lipinski's rule of five which is a thumb rule to evaluate the druglikeness or determine if a chemical compound with certain pharmacological or biological activity has properties that can be used in oral administration of the drug.

Overall he emphasized the fact that in 21st century the cost of discovering a new drug has gone up substantially and outcomes are very few drugs which cause a immense financial burden on the companies because it is not recoverable or it has to be passed on to other successful drugs in future which make the treatment unaffordable to many people.

Finally the programme ended with vote of thanks by Dr. Akshatha Salian and the program was compered by Ms Jyoti Vas.

International webinar on Culture, Language and Identity

“Today, humans have become cyborgs,” said Prof. G N Devy, renowned cultural critic at the international webinar by St Aloysius College (Autonomous) addressing on the theme, Culture, Language and Identity. He opined that these three problematic and complex concepts have been at the centre of debates and dialogues among scholars and intellectuals. The webinar was organized under UGC-STRIDE Scheme of the College.



Innumerable philosophical debates and struggles have taken place on language and culture. Colonial regimes were not just about the land and wealth but also were about culture. We must understand that the violence that was unleashed and perpetrated due to the division of the society was primarily to do with the question of identity. Prof. Devy referred to Sir Thomas Brown's book *Pseudodoxia Epidemica* published 400 hundred years ago having contemporary relevance to the pandemic. Contagion does not affect the body but controls one's mind and thoughts. The anthropological history started with the sapiens and travelled thousands of stages and reached the enlightenment age and presently we are in the virtual, cyber age. Cyber space is not visible to our naked eyes. It exists in our consciousness in the form of images and metaphors. Hence the question of identity, culture and language have been redefined, reinterpreted and reproduced. In this understanding of identity, we are presented with tools and technologies of Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning offering us a 'digital' identity. We have reached a stage where our identities are reduced to a digital number and are struggling to approximate ourselves to that numerical, digital identity which has nothing to do with the individual's identity. Humanity has reached the stage where the digital and cyber space lead-



ing to an almost inevitable cyber empire. The bombardment of the digital and cyber space and technologies need to countered and alternative discourses regarding culture, language and identities must be fostered. Prof. Devy advised students, scholars and the faculty to evolve a new lingo and resist the onslaught of cyber culture and its dehumanizing impact. The Principal of the College, Rev. Dr Praveen Martis, SJ, emphasized the need

for regular dialogues on culture, language and identity in the contemporary context.

The Coordinator of the UGC-STRIDE Scheme Dr Alwyn D'Sa, in his introductory note briefed the participants on the novel scheme and said that there would be a series of webinars under STRIDE in the coming days. Dr Ratan Mohunta, Head, department of English moderated the interventions by participants. Dr Dinesh Nayak, the convener of the webinar introduced the resource person, Prof. Devy. 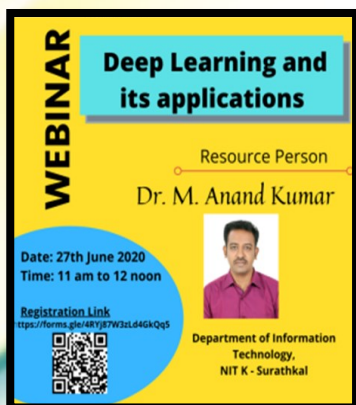

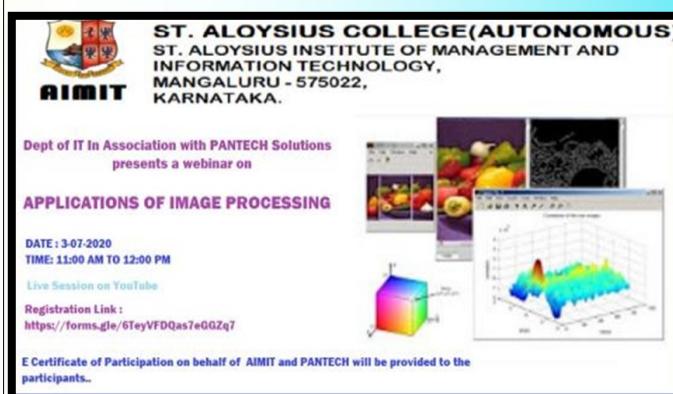
The session was streamed live on Youtube for the benefit of the participants, and all the participants were given a participation certificate.

Data Science in Current scenario

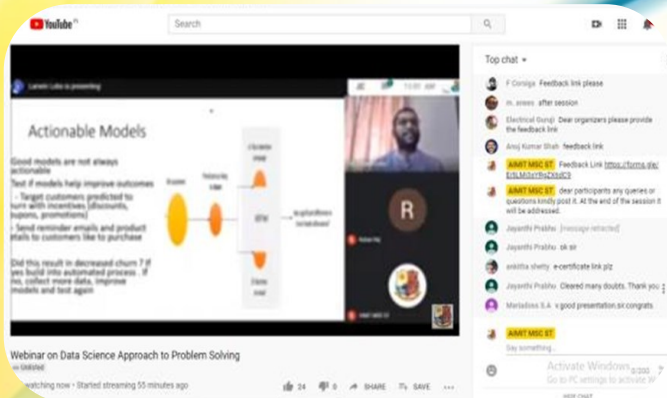

India's First Trained Art Curator, Dr Alka Raghuvanshi, Addresses The Issue Of "Dwindling Folk Performing Arts" In An International Webinar organized By St Aloysius College Autonomous, Mangalore

The Dept. of Sociology, St Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangalore, under the aegis of STRIDE (Scheme for Trans-Disciplinary Research for India's Developing Economy), organized an international webinar on the theme "Dwindling Folk Performing Arts" on 12th August 2020. Dr Alka Raghuvanshi who is India's first trained art curator, having trained at the Goldsmiths College, London and the Museum of Modern Art in Oxford, was the speaker of the day. With a writing career of on the arts spanning nearly 40 years, she has authored and edited over 32 books on the perform. A senior columnist and author, she has been on the Editorial Teams of the Indian Express, The Times of India, Pioneer and The BBC, where she consistently wrote to cover the entire spectrum of the Arts.

The webinar began with a welcome note from the Convener and HOD, Dept. of Sociology, Ms Joan Rita O'Brien, followed by a short video with about 12 dwindling folk performing arts was showcased and presented to the participants. Following which Dr Alwyn D'Sa, the Chief Coordinator of STRIDE and the Controller of Examinations, St Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangalore, gave a brief introduction about STRIDE and what it aims to achieve. Rev. Fr. Dr Praveen Martis, SJ, Principal of St Aloysius College (Autonomous) Mangalore, delivered his opening remarks on the webinar where he shared his concern about the dying forms of folk theatre and art.

The speaker started her talk with her memories and experiences about *Yakshagana* of Karnataka talking about both dance and drama in the same breath. Being perturbed by the tragedy of Indian theatre and dance and drama, she spoke about the origin of folk theatres and its connection to Mahabharat and Ramayan. She almost gave a visual detailing of the puppet performance of *Yakshagana (Gombeyatta)* and how it is exhibited to a smaller seated audience given the size of the puppets; making a mention that India is the only country in the world where all the four forms of puppetry still exist (shadow puppets, String puppets, rod puppets and the hand puppets). Dr Alka mentioned how she was involved in the government's literacy mission work and how she reached out to people of several parts of the country (14 states) through folk performers. Folk performance was used in a very unique way to spread the message of literacy, hygiene, health, environment etc. as it is a useful tool to reach out to a large group of people.

At the same time she spoke of the dwindling number of *Ram Lilas* in the north and her memories as a child.

With other forms of entertainment taking over, folk theatre is getting marginalised. Even the TV performance or a live recording of theatre could never capture the real magic of the live performance. Earlier being invited to portray a character in *Ram Lila* would be considered a big privilege and the person performing it would be worshipped for those ten days as if they were actually the incarnations of Lord Ram/Sita etc.

The *Ram Lila* of Benaras and its changing venues every day and the role of the king of Benaras are unique. It is still held in Benaras and there is an audience; there are performances and she emphasized that we need to make them survive, viable and help in their sustenance. Also the *Ram Lila* of Kullu Manali and the "Long horn" that is played by the villagers who are not necessarily performers is again a spectacular performance.

Dr Alka Raghuvanshi explained the *Ram Lila* of Gujarat and Rajasthan where it is performed with *ghoomar* and *dandia* and here the goddess Amba is worshipped which is more dance related than theatre. *Bhavai* of Gujarat has a large repertoire of drama though.

Swang (folk theatre) in Haryana and parts of Punjab can at times get frightening because they are basically under disguise and take on various forms and she shared one of her real life experience. Women were not really part of the discourse at all. It was men who took up the female characters (*stree vesham*) like in almost all the parts of country. Even the musicians and singers were men. It's only in the past 40 years that women have been allowed to perform their roles.

The *Bhand Pather* of Kashmir is another form of folk performance which is more music oriented and it is the *tumbak nadi*, a percussion instrument which is used.

Dr Alka made a special mention of a remarkable performer and artist Teejan Bai who was a one woman army show with just one instrument (*ek taara*). Someone who could keep the audience glued to the performance of just a single woman performing the entire Mahabharata.

She spoke of how the North East has lost many forms of indigenous theatre forever for many reasons (one of it being insurgency), yet they have beautiful troupes who do amazing performances and they compete. Surprisingly the erstwhile king used to also compete in the same.

She also mentioned about how the use of the head gear sets Indian folk performance apart. Every region has its own head gears and also the make up or *shringaar* (which has evolved tremendously over the years) similar to the head gear is unique to each folk form.

Dr Raghuvanshi concluded with how some folk dances have been also intelligently and with a lot of hard work transformed and evolved into classical dance forms by Guru Kelucharan Mohapatra (Odissi) and Pt. Birju Maharaj (Kathak).

The last part of the webinar was an interactive session with questions (moderated by Ms Joan Rita O'Brien) for Dr Alka Raghuvanshi from participants from Nagaland, UP, Karnataka, Kerala, Manipur, West Bengal, Jharkhand etc. and she answered them all with her experience, research and expertise with complete detailing.

The Webinar ended with a vote of thanks proposed by the convener and HOD, Dept. of Sociology, Ms Joan Rita O'Brien.

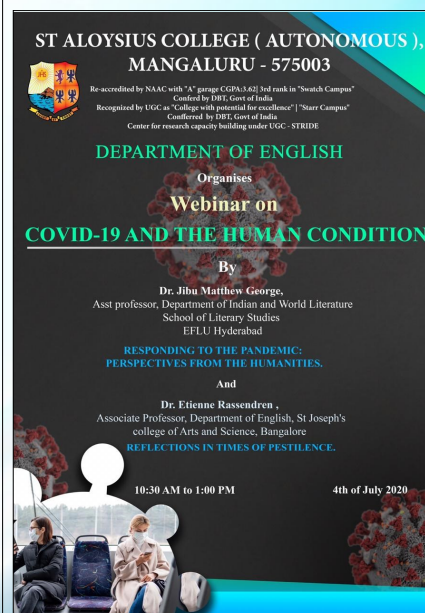

- Mahindra set up a team to produce AMBU Bag respirators low cost, frugal respirators
- Mahindra Rise an subsidiary of M&M worked with SkanRay technologies to develop this Bag Valve Mask Ventilator (Commonly called as AMBU Bag ventilator)
- These frugal ventilators cost Rs. 7500
- These would meet the growing need/ demand of the respirators during this virus outbreak



COVID era'. Mr. James began the presentation by highlighting the prioritization of various commodities and sectors in the post COVID era. He also mentioned that the major concern for logistics companies in these times would be on how to improve profitability and competitiveness of the supply chain.

Quoting the research of Ivanov and Dolgui (2020), the speaker explained that sustainable practices (sustainability) and agility are the key ways to improve supply chain management. Mr James also reminded the participants about the significance of the 12th goal of sustainable development (2030 Sustainable Development Agenda) in the post COVID era, i.e. 'responsible consumption and production' and explained the relevance of closed loop supply chain management and sustainable practices in manufacturing. He concluded the session by stating that the COVID pandemic would accelerate the process of deglobalisation and reshoring.

In the second session on August 25, 2020, Mr. Ravi Kudtarkar, assistant professor, Dept. of MBA, AIMIT, spoke about the 'Opportunities for India to progress in a post pandemic world - a logistics and supply chain perspective'. Mr Kudtarkar commenced the session by discussing the business scenario in sectors of automobiles, pharmaceutical and consumer goods. He articulated on how there was a transformation in the conduct of business from the start of the pandemic till date.

Mr Kudtarkar listed out case studies from firms belonging to small scale industry sector, large scale industry sector and public sector so as to explain how these firms were adaptable and agile to meet the need of the time. In continuation to the discussion, the 'Spiral of prosperity' model was explained and applied in the context of Indian economy. This model explained the path ahead to recuperate the Indian economy situation post pandemic. The session concluded by discoursing on the impact of China on the global supply chain. The deliberation led to many new frameworks that can be implemented in the public-policy formation.

In the final session on August 26, 2020, Mr. Jeevan Lawrence, assistant professor, department of MBA, AIMIT, spoke about the 'Trends in retail and manufacturing industries during COVID'. He explained how manufacturers and retailers have responded to the current crisis and also the roadmap for these industries in the future. Few case studies on best practices by manufacturing and retail organizations were discussed during the session. The information shared was based on primary data collected from industry experts in manufacturing and retail organizations. The session ended with a note of thanks by the Dean, Dr Rowena Wright.

Webinar Series: 'Fostering Well-Being And Developing Resilience During Covid Times

The PG department of MBA organized the 4th national webinar on 'Fostering well-being and developing resilience during COVID times' on August 14, 2020. The facilitator and wellness initiator was Rector of St Aloysius Institutions, Fr Dionysius Vaz SJ.

Fr Vaz began his talk by speaking about the current pandemic and how it had forced people to become creative, risk taking, and forward looking. He questioned



whether we are still in the fear zone or we have risen to the learning zone.

Fr Vaz went on to say that irrespective of one's calling, our ultimate purpose is

to bring joy to others by loving and serving them. Then the concept of Ikigai was explained. "Ikigai is a Japanese concept that means 'a reason for being'. The word refers to having a purpose in life, that which makes one's life worthwhile, and which gives satisfaction and a sense of meaning to life," he said. He advised the participants to make a list of things they are good at, passionate about, what they could be paid for and what the world needs today to come to a conclusion to find ones purpose.

Later, Fr Vaz explained 10 ways in which one could build resilience: "Make connections, avoid seeing crises as insurmountable problems, accept that change is a part of living, move towards your goals, take decisive actions, look for opportunities for self discovery, nurture a positive view of yourself, keep things in perspective, maintain a hopeful outlook and take care of yourself."

The webinar was followed by a very interesting and healthy discussion on coping with challenges of the pandemic. Several questions were raised and Fr Vaz answered them with great clarity and experience.

Earlier, Dr Rowena Wright, Dean (Academics) introduced and welcomed the resource person and the participants. Dr Rajani Suresh proposed the vote of thanks. This webinar was attended by nearly 350 participants from across the country. The webinar was coordinated by Mr Clifford D'Costa, and Fr Joy Rodrigues SJ moderated the session.

The Pandemic and the future of Capitalism

The Department of English (UG) organized an International Conference on the topic “The Pandemic and the future of Capitalism” on the 13th of August 2020, at Sanidhya between 1.00pm and 4.00pm. The participant’s number was 215.

The conference began by invoking God’s Blessings. Later Rev. Dr Praveen Martis the principal addressed the participants. In his opening remarks he expressed his concern about the time

The PG Department of Chemistry at St Aloysius College Mangalore has an outstanding academic atmosphere with qualified faculties and have excellent research facilities with 5 research supervisors affiliated to Mangalore University. Sadbhavana Diwas is observed every year on 20th August. Sadbhavana Diwas 2020 is celebrated to commemorate

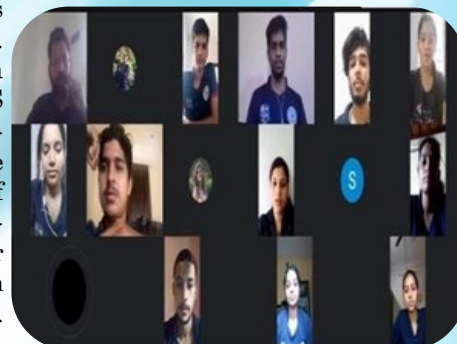

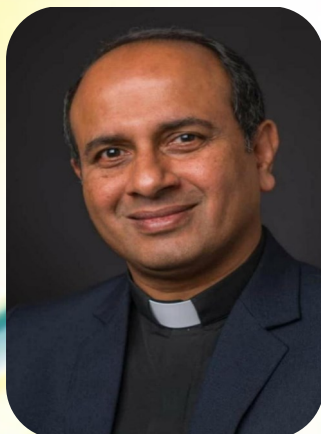
